I. HEARTHSTONE CYO BASKETBALL

The Hearthstone high school basketball league is offered to parishes in the Saint George, Blessed Junipero and Saint Francis of Assisi Deaneries. A parish high school league is offered for both boys and girls. This league will follow “National Federation High School” rules unless otherwise noted in the rules below and/or the “CYO Basketball General Rules”.

- Tuesday, November 17th - **Deadline** to enter a team in the league (submit \$100 team fee with entry)
- Saturday, November 21st - Coaches’ Initial Certification session @ Bryan, St. Patrick - 9:00am - 1:30pm
- Wednesday, Nov. 25th - League schedules will be posted on the website by 5:00 PM
CYO Office is closed at 12:00 noon for a Diocesan function
- Monday, November 30th - **Deadline** to submit team rosters

III. ADMISSION FEES

There will be an admission fee charged for spectators at all Hearthstone games. The price, which was agreed upon, will be \$1 for grade school students and \$2 for adults (high school and older). This same price must be used at each gym in the "Hearthstone" league throughout the season.

IV. SCHEDULE OF LEAGUE GAMES

- A. The league and tournament schedules will be posted on the CYO website <www.cyss.org/CYO/index.htm>. There will be no schedules mailed to the head coaches. All of the boy's teams will play each team in the league one time. The girl's league will play a double round.
- B. Any game listed as TBA must be scheduled between the two coaches. These games on the boys schedule must be played by Sunday, January 24th.
- C. There will be a league tournament for the boys division.
- D. There will not be a league tournament for the girls division.

V. REFEREES

Each team is responsible for bringing an OHSAA licensed referee with them for each game. If the visiting team cannot supply a licensed referee they must notify the home team at least three days before the game so that they may attempt to secure a replacement. Each team is responsible for paying the referee which they hire (unless a different agreement is made at the pre-season coaches meeting).

VI. REPORTING SCORES

The winning coach must notify the CYO office the results of each game. This may be done by phone, fax or e-mail. No collect phone calls will be accepted. These scores should be reported within 24 hours of the game so that standings may be kept updated.

VII. CONCLUSION

1. GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP should be practiced in all games. If there is a violation in one of your games, PLEASE notify the CYO Office. This is your league! Please do your part as a coach to make sure that it remains a good league.
